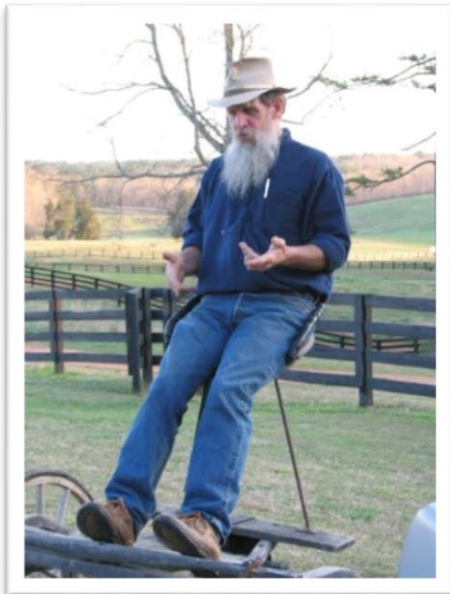


Middle Tennessee Carriage Club announces

Directions to 304 Coldwater Creek Rd, Taft, TN:

From I 65, take TN exit 1 toward Ardmore. Turn left on TN 110. Go 9.6 miles to Robertson Hollow Rd. Turn left and follow it until it T's into Coldwater Creek Rd. Turn left. The Bunton's farm is the first drive on the left.

From Fayetteville, TN, take TN 110 for 7.4 miles. Turn right on Coldwater Creek Rd. Continue for 3 miles. The Bunton's farm is on left.
